The five-year projection for the population in the area is 183,599 representing a change of 1.13% annually from 2019 to 2024. Currently, the population is 47.9% male and 52.1% female.

Currently, 60.3% of the 75,201 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 33.1%, renter occupied; and 6.6% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.4% are renter occupied; and 11.2% are vacant. In 2010, there were 69,234 housing units in the area - 58.4% owner occupied, 33.7% renter occupied, and 7.9% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 3.74%. Median home value in the area is \$207,493, compared to a median home value of \$234,154 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.62% annually to \$236,135.
