Currently, 54.8% of the 145,561 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 37.1%, renter occupied; and 8.1% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.4% are renter occupied; and 11.2% are vacant. In 2010, there were 123,385 housing units in the area - 55.7% owner occupied, 35.1% renter occupied, and 9.2% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 7.62%. Median home value in the area is \$225,552, compared to a median home value of \$234,154 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.84% annually to \$259,395.
