Current median household income is \$57,053 in the area, compared to \$64,730 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$62,222 in five years, compared to \$72,932 for all U.S. households

Current average household income is \$74,246 in this area, compared to \$90,054 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$83,362 in five years, compared to \$103,679 for all U.S. households

Current per capita income is \$29,845 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$34,136. The per capita income is projected to be \$33,473 in five years, compared to \$39,378 for all U.S. households

Currently, 58.8% of the 56,898 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 24.6%, renter occupied; and 16.6% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 57.3% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.2% are renter occupied; and 11.5% are vacant. In 2010, there were 57,082 housing units in the area - 53.5% owner occupied, 32.0% renter occupied, and 14.5% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is -0.14%. Median home value in the area is \$223,708, compared to a median home value of \$264,021 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.99% annually to \$259,236.
