Currently, 48.8% of the 101,530 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 19.7%, renter occupied; and 31.5% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 58.2% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.8% are renter occupied; and 10.0% are vacant. In 2020, there were 98,653 housing units in the area and 31.1% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 1.29%. Median home value in the area is \$257,529, compared to a median home value of \$283,272 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 3.11% annually to \$300,144.
