The five-year projection for the population in the area is 117,392 representing a change of 0.02% annually from 2023 to 2028. Currently, the population is 48.4% male and 51.6% female.

The number of families in the current year is 30,808 in the specified area.

Socioeconomic Status Index

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Currently, 63.9% of the 51,056 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 30.5%, renter occupied; and 5.7% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 58.5% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.7% are renter occupied; and 9.8% are vacant. In 2020, there were 50,682 housing units in the area and 5.6% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 0.23%. Median home value in the area is \$338,421, compared to a median home value of \$308,943 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 0.88% annually to \$353,561.

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
