The five-year projection for the population in the area is 567,771 representing a change of 0.26% annually from 2024 to 2029. Currently, the population is 49.7% male and 50.3% female.

The median age in this area is 35.4, compared to U.S. median age of 39.3.

Persons of Hispanic origin represent 22.4% of the population in the identified area compared to 19.6% of the U.S. population. Persons of Hispanic Origin may be of any race. The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 80.9 in the identified area, compared to 72.5 for the U.S. as a whole.

The five-year projection of households is 251,438, a change of 0.53% annually from the current year total. Average household size is currently 2.26, compared to 2.28 in the year 2020. The number of families in the current year is 125,560 in the specified area.

Current median household income is \$97,221 in the area, compared to \$79,068 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$113,468 in five years, compared to \$91,442 all U.S. households.

Current average household income is \$148,432 in this area, compared to \$113,185 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$171,749 in five years, compared to \$130,581 for all U.S. households.

Current per capita income is \$64,909 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$43,829. The per capita income is projected to be \$76,091 in five years, compared to \$51,203 for all U.S. households.

Currently, 43.4% of the 264,517 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 49.2%, renter occupied; and 7.4% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 57.9% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.1% are renter occupied; and 10.0% are vacant. In 2020, there were 258,416 housing units in the area and 7.6% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 0.55%. Median home value in the area is \$523,504, compared to a median home value of \$355,577 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.68% annually to \$597,613.

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
