In the identified area, the current year population is 180,276. In 2020, the Census count in the area was 169,343. The rate of change since 2020 was 1.48% annually. The five-year projection for the population in the area is 187,533 representing a change of 0.79% annually from 2024 to 2029. Currently, the population is 50.4% male and 49.6% female.

The median age in this area is 42.4, compared to U.S. median age of 39.3.

The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 54.0 in the identified area, compared to 72.5 for the U.S. as a whole.

The five-year projection of households is 77,297, a change of 1.15% annually from the current year total. Average household size is currently 2.43, compared to 2.45 in the year 2020. The number of families in the current year is 47,158 in the specified area.

Current median household income is \$71,201 in the area, compared to \$79,068 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$86,559 in five years, compared to \$91,442 all U.S. households.

Current average household income is \$99,531 in this area, compared to \$113,185 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$117,752 in five years, compared to \$130,581 for all U.S. households.

Current per capita income is \$40,379 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$43,829. The per capita income is projected to be \$48,617 in five years, compared to \$51,203 for all U.S. households.

Currently, 46.3% of the 105,033 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 23.2%, renter occupied; and 30.5% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 57.9% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.1% are renter occupied; and 10.0% are vacant. In 2020, there were 98,302 housing units in the area and 31.5% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 1.57%. Median home value in the area is \$347,764, compared to a median home value of \$355,577 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 4.28% annually to \$428,892.

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
