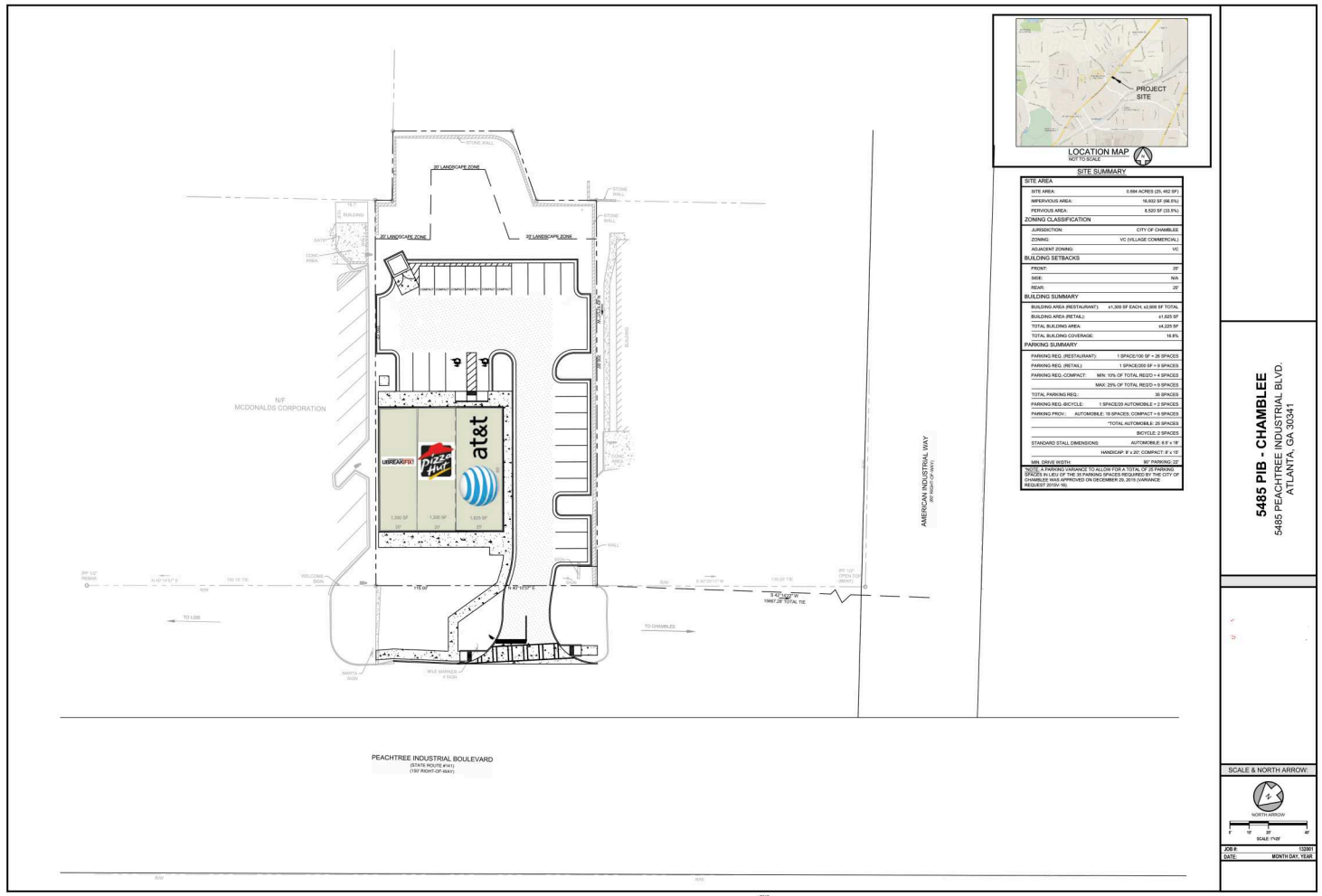

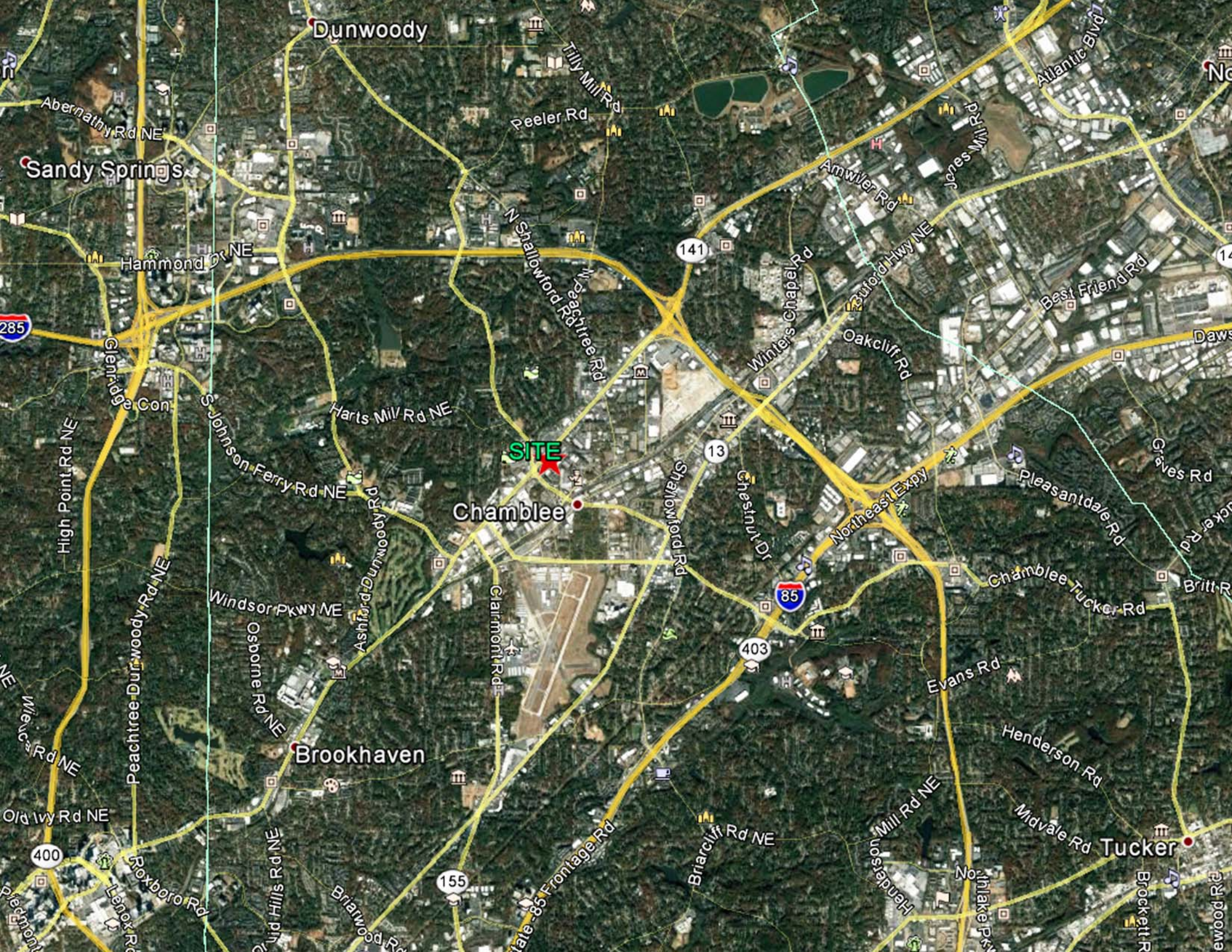

Currently, 39.2% of the 251,277 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 51.7%, renter occupied; and 9.1% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.0% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.8% are renter occupied; and 11.2% are vacant. In 2010, there were 229,491 housing units in the area - 43.3% owner occupied, 46.3% renter occupied, and 10.4% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 4.11%. Median home value in the area is \$354,272, compared to a median home value of \$218,492 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 1.88% annually to \$388,855.
